## Rules and Regulations (please retain this page)

All organisations enter the Heart of Gisborne Children's Christmas Parade entirely at their own risk and indemnify parade organisers and its officials against all liability arising out of their participation in the parade or its related activities.

All entries are to reflect the spirit and celebratory nature of the Parade. Any entry deemed to be inappropriate (offensive or disturbing to the Parade audience - primarily children) will be respectfully ejected from the Parade. If you have an issue you wish to address / promote through the Parade please discuss it on registration with Parade organisers – experienced marketers who may be able to assist you to promote your issue in a positive and appropriate way.

All entrants must provide a minimum of two (walking) marshals for each vehicle.

There is to be no throwing of lollies/merchandise from vehicles. Walkers are able to hand lollies / merchandise to onlookers but must not encourage them to move forward – you must go to them.

Speed in the assembly area must be kept to an absolute minimum – there are literally hundreds of excited kids running around the vicinity – please ensure utmost care.

All participants must abide by the rules of the parade and adhere to any reasonable request made by the Parade organisers, parade officials, and Police and/or council representatives.

It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that vehicles and floats are safe to use by their participants.

## Fees

To help cover the costs of the street closures we ask that participants make a small contribution as follows:

- \$50 Corporate Entry
- \$25 Community Group / Non-profit Organisation and School or Preschool Entries
